

RE Labs 'The Whitelist' Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to us. It is RE Labs' policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect from you for providing The Whitelist application. This privacy policy describes the data we collect and how it is processed.

RE Labs is The Data Controller

We are the controller in accordance with current privacy legislation. Your information is processed in order to deliver The Whitelist application; to allow music industry professionals to identify emerging talent.

Information We Collect, Why, and for How Long

Information from Customers

We collect information that our customers provide us to enable them to log on to The Whitelist. This data consists of their name and company. We hold this information until the user is no longer a customer, at which point their account is disabled and the data removed.

Information from Social Media and Music Sites

We collect data about musicians that is made available to The Whitelist by Social Media and Music sites such as Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, Spotify, SoundCloud and others through APIs or web crawling technology. This data includes names, user IDs, social media handles, and other information that musicians choose to make publicly available on those sites.

The purpose for collecting this data is to identify musicians that are becoming popular.

Unless the musician requests in writing, we hold this information for as long as we deem it necessary in order to deliver The Whitelist.

Your Rights

You have the right to revoke consent to processing your information. If you are a Customer, revoking consent may mean you lose access to The Whitelist application. If you are a musician who has a profile in our system, revoking consent will mean your information will be removed from the app, and you will not appear to any users of the app.

You have under certain circumstances a right to data portability, which means a right to get the personal data and transfer these to another controller as long as this does not negatively affect the rights and freedoms of others.

You have the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority regarding the processing of personal data relating to him or her, if you consider that the processing of personal data infringes the legal framework of privacy law.
